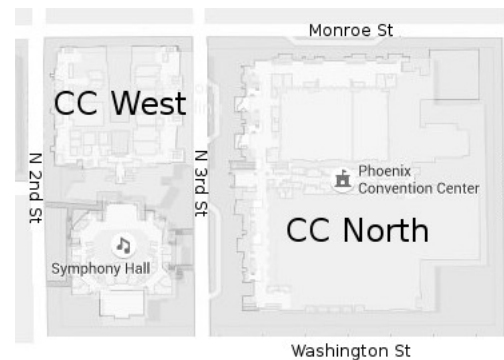

All steampunk programming this year will be at the Convention Center!

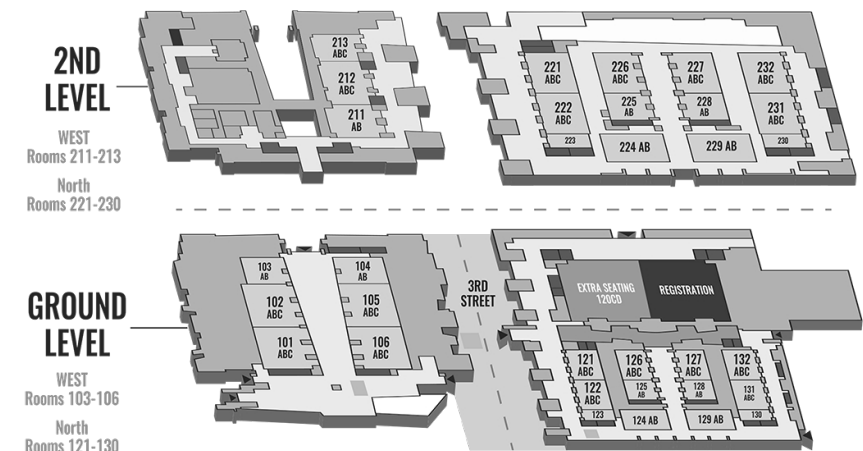
We have two dedicated rooms for the Steampunk track this year (104A and 104B), which can be found in the **West Building**.
